

# Bull City Burger and Brewery's OctoBullFest Contest Rules and Regulations

## Contest #1: The Whistlefest Race

- **Time & Location:** 4 PM to 4:30 PM September 21st on Parrish Street.
- **Summary:** Contestants must eat all of their pretzels and the first to whistle the entire Happy Birthday song wins. There is an under 10 years of age and over 10 years of age category for each race.
- **Description:** This is an individual competition limited to 10 contestants maximum. The under 10 age group will go first. Each contestant will be given a cup of pretzels to eat and swallow. At the starter's signal, each contestant must eat all of their pretzels as quickly as possible. No water or other liquid beverage may be consumed during the competition. Any pretzel or portion of a pretzel that falls to the ground will be replaced by a full pretzel as determined by a judge. When a contestant finishes all of their pretzels they must then whistle the entire Happy Birthday song. The first to finish all their pretzels and whistle the entire song will be the winner. The judges will determine the winner. The song must be whistled clearly for the judges to hear.

Please include your full name, a phone contact number and if you are in the under 10 or over 10 age group. Arrive by 3:30 PM to check in.
- **Prizes:** The under 10 group will have a first and second place winner with prizes TBD. The over 10 age group will have one winner. The winner receives a \$25 gift card to either Bull City Burger and Brewery or Pompieri Pizza.
- **Fine Print:** Anyone deemed too intoxicated to race will be removed as determined by a judge. Any cheaters will be disqualified as determined by the judges. 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## Contest #2: The Running of the Bulls Race

- **Time & Location:** 7:30 PM to 8 PM September 21st on Parrish Street.
- **Summary:** Contestants work as a team to complete 3 stages to win. Stage 1 is the ring toss. Stage 2 is the running of the bulls to fill a pitcher. Stage 3 is the drinking of Stierstadt Octoberfest lager. All contestants must be 21+ years of age - ID required to participate.
- **Description:** This is a group competition for 2 people per team. You choose your team. This is limited to 4 teams maximum. Stage 1: Contestants will wear helmets with horns

on their heads, which we provide, and safety glasses, which we provide. You and a partner must toss rings to one another five feet apart, and catch them on the your helmet's horns. The catchers cannot use their hands. You will be given 6 rings and you must catch 3 on each helmet. If one falls off, it must be re-tossed until you each have three. If the ring bounces off, you must get it and return to your position. Proceed to stage 2. Stage 2: While wearing the helmets on your heads with rings, each of you must run around two cones set 30 feet apart. At the furthest cone, there will be a bucket of water. As you pass the water, you will use the provided stack cup to scoop up water and run it back to the first cone to fill a vessel. The first team to fill the vessel to the top will complete stage 2. If a ring falls off, you must stop and re-toss the ring at the ring tossing location in order to begin again. Once you have finished filling the vessel with water proceed to stage 3. Stage 3: Each member of the team will be given a 10 ounce glass of Oktoberfest lager for stage 3. The first team to finish every glass of beer without spilling will be the winning team.

- **Summary:** Up to 10 contestants can participate. You must hold three stack cups filled with water by their handles nested in one hand with your arm straight out parallel to the ground. The last person to lower their cups wins. You cannot change hands or arms.
- **Description:** At the sound of the start whistle, all contestants must place their cups straight out in front of them with a straight arm. As the arm gets tired the cups will be lowered. The last person to hold their cups out wins.
- **Prizes:** The winning person receives a glass beer mug with a t-shirt of their choice.
- **Fine Print:** All ages can participate. Anyone deemed too intoxicated will be removed as determined by a judge. Any cheaters will be disqualified as determined by the judges.
